

7a. Environmental Analysis

The City will prepare an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) to identify and mitigate the environmental impacts of implementing the updated General Plan, Housing Element, and Climate Action Plan. A robust EIR will analyze impacts to all resource categories required under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) at a programmatic level and streamline environmental review for subsequent projects envisioned under the plans.


