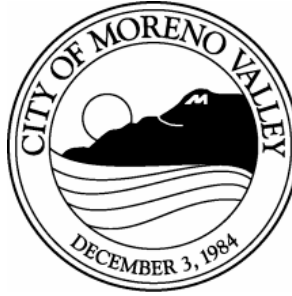

1. PRELIMINARY DRAFT GENERAL PLAN LAND USE MAP AND CITYWIDE PROJECTIONS FOR POPULATION, HOUSING UNITS AND EMPLOYMENT IN 2040

Considering the key findings of the existing conditions report, input from the community received to date, and feedback from the GPAC, City staff and the consultant will present a preliminary general plan land use map that will guide development and conservation in Moreno Valley through 2040. Additionally, a preliminary set of citywide projections for population, housing, and job growth will be presented in view of regional growth projections and the proposed land use changes. The objective of the May 21 meeting is to review the proposed land use map, land use designations, and buildout projections with the GPAC and receive feedback before review by the Planning Commission on May 28.
