

## City of Moreno Valley Emerging Leaders Council Recognition Program

<u>Purpose</u>: To recognize outstanding high-school students in Moreno Valley. Applicants must be able to showcase their personal or group related activity, which have positively affected student life. Ideal candidates have contributed to the enrichment of the school and community, and have demonstrated one or more of the following traits: ability to motivate self and others, creativity, collaboration, integrity, balance, participates in extra-curricular activities and exhibits pride in their school, volunteers time and services to the members of the community

Eligibility: Applicants must be a high school student in good academic standing and have a minimum GPA of 2.0.

<u>Selection Process</u>: Applications are due the first Wednesday of each month for consideration by the ELC for an award the following month. The application will be reviewed by staff and submitted to the Emerging Leaders Council for consideration at a regularly scheduled Emerging Leaders Council meeting. Approval of the application shall be made by an affirmative vote by a majority of the ELC.

<u>Award Process</u>: Nominees and the nominating party will be notified via email. Recognition of the award will occur at the regularly scheduled Emerging Leaders Council meeting following the selection. Annually, as a group, all winners will be recognized at a City Council meeting in May.
