NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Moreno Valley is now accepting applications for the Accessibility Appeals Board. The appointees shall be bona fide residents and registered voters of the City of Moreno Valley at the time of appointment and throughout their incumbencies and will serve without compensation for designated terms. In addition, the appointees shall attend at least one meeting prior to the appointments (This requirement does not apply to the Accessibility Appeals Board).

The Accessibility Appeals Board conducts hearings on written appeals regarding Title 24 accessibility issues brought by any person aggrieved by enforcement action taken by the Building Division of the Community and Economic Development Department of the City of Moreno Valley, and render decisions regarding accessibility “hardship” cases as prescribed by the State’s Title 24 Accessibility Regulations. Hearings shall be held within 30 days of receipt of an appeal.
