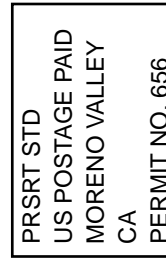

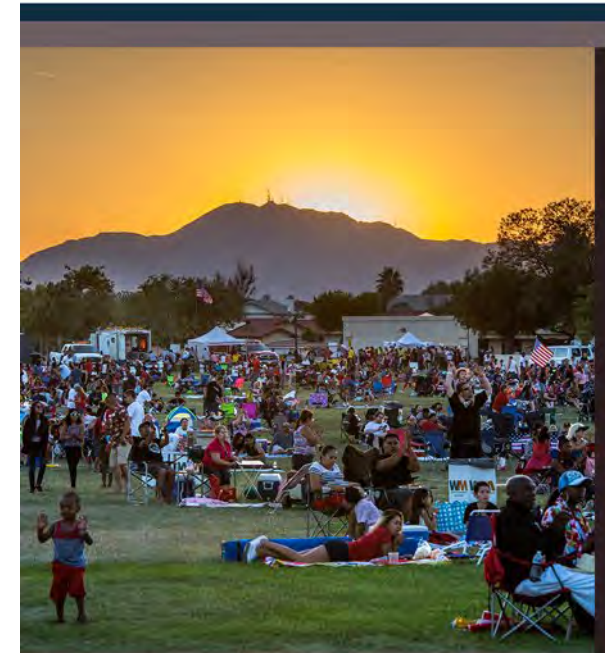

2016 ANNUAL UPDATE



DEAR PROPERTY OWNER

We are excited to update you on the services and activities within your City's special districts. These districts provide the financial resources to maintain parks and trails, offer our award winning 4th of July Celebration and annual Easter Egg Hunt, maintain public parkway and median landscaping, and operate our street lighting program. WATER CONSERVATION

The City continues to conserve water while striving to balance a healthy appearance to public landscaping. During 2016, we:

- Replaced over 500,000 square feet of water thirsty grass with water-wise plant material and drip irrigation using the County of Riverside Guide to California Friendly Landscaping as a resource.
- Received a \$982,554 grant from Metropolitan Water District, which funded the majority of the costs to remove the water thirsty grass.
- Reduced potable water use for public landscaping by 62% of Eastern Municipal Water District's Allowance.
- Routinely conducted irrigation audits and monitored water usage by using a centralized irrigation system and staff who are Certified Irrigation Auditors.
- Required new development projects to install drought tolerant landscaping, water efficient irrigation, and centralized irrigation equipment in public landscape areas. Recycled water is used when available.

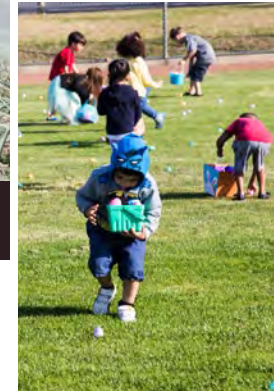

REPORT NONWORKING STREET LIGHTS

Street lights are owned, operated, and maintained by either Southern California Edison (SCE) or Moreno Valley Utility (MVU). Both utility providers assign a distinct pole number to each street light. SCE places a vertical strip on the pole, just above eye level, with a 7 digit number ending with the letter "E". MVU street lights are identified by a 3-4 digit pole number located at the base of the pole and usually ends with "MV" or "MVU".

Most street light repairs will occur within 10-15 working days. If extensive repairs are needed, the utility provider will schedule additional crews to complete the work. Extensive repairs may take up to 30 working days. When this is necessary, a colored ribbon is placed around the pole until the repairs are completed.
