

Most residential customers will see the following electric charges:

- Basic Charge base charge for providing a meter and associated services, such as meter reading and customer services.
- Energy Charges all residential customers are charged on a Tier structure based on the time of year and time of day of service.

- Public Purpose This charge recovers costs for administering state mandated programs such as discounts and energy efficiency programs.



- CA Energy Resource Charge also referred to as the State Energy Surcharge a passthrough fee collected by the State of California for research into alternative sources of renewable energy.
- Utility Users Tax (UUT) is a 5.75% charge on utility activity in Moreno Valley that is assessed on energy, water, sewer, cable, wireless and telephone charges.
