





2023 Challenge – Large Breed Dogs


"I am about over 60 dogs over capacity right now..." 11/3/22 – San Bernardino City Shelter

"We have 24 dogs in paid boarding at \$700 per month each and all of our facilities are full. Couple that with very slow adoptions and we are in a log jam. Or dog jam so to speak." – 2/22/2023 – Non-Profit Rescue Partner in Orange County, CA

"Here I am asking again if anyone has room for large breed puppies that we have in shelter." -2/28/23 - Stockton, CA

"We have the capacity for 202 dogs and are currently at 264. I understand that we are all dealing with an increase in shelter population and struggling all around, but any help with placement or resources that you can provide would be greatly appreciated." – 3/10/23 - County of Orange Animal Shelter

Moreno Valley Animal Shelter 4/3/23 – 64% over capacity – 100 dogs – designed for 61 dogs



Meeting the Challenge

- Shelter Expansion Proposal 4 Phases
- Phase 1 Expand Healthy Dog Intake from 12 to 36 kennels (funded)
- Phase 2 Block Wall Perimeter security on Animal Shelter site (unfunded)
- Phase 3 Animal Shelter Expansion 5,000 sf to increase capacity (unfunded)
- Phase 4 Refurbishment of air scrubbers and ADA upgrades in existing building (unfunded)
- Special Adoption Promotions Minimize the Impacts of Overcrowding


