



CITY OF MORENO VALLEY NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD 2025/2026 CAPER

As a recipient of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME), and Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) funds, the City of Moreno Valley (City) is required to prepare a Consolidated Annual Performance Evaluation Report (CAPER) for the period of July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026. Pursuant to 24 CFR 91.520, the City will submit the CAPER to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) by September 30, 2026.

The CAPER provides an opportunity to evaluate the City's progress in implementing the priorities and objectives identified in its HUD-approved 2023–2028 Consolidated Plan and 2025 Annual Action Plan, and to report those accomplishments to HUD and the residents of Moreno Valley.

The City encourages public participation and invites residents to review and comment on the CAPER. The document will be available for a fifteen (15)-day public comment period from September 3, 2026, through September 18, 2026, ending at 5:00 p.m. (PDT).

Following the close of the public comment period, the City will consider all comments received, revise the CAPER as appropriate to include a summary of those comments, and submit the final report to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.
