

# CALIFORNIA ARREARAGE Payment Program

The California Arrearage Payment Program Bill Credit is courtesy of a state program to help pay eligible energy utility bills that increased during the COVID-19 pandemic. The California Arrearage Payment Program, or CAPP, reduces qualified customers' unpaid energy bills by directly applying a credit to their energy bill.

CAPP is designed to help utility customers that fell behind on their energy bills because of the economic impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic. Customers may qualify for CAPP if they had an unpaid energy utility bill over 60 days past due incurred between March 4, 2020 and June 15, 2021.

Customers do not need to apply for CAPP. If you're eligible for CAPP assistance, Moreno Valley Utility (MVU) will apply a CAPP Bill Credit directly to your account.
