



#### Registration and Fee Information

- Registration is accepted online at RegisterMoVal.org or at the Parks & Community Services office at 14075 Frederick Street, Moreno Valley, CA 92553.
- 2. Registration is accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.
- 3. All fees must be paid at the time of registration.
- Registration fees for all programs and activities, including monthly classes, are due at least three working days prior to the activity and must be paid in full.
- 5. Participants must bring a paid receipt to the first class.
- 6. A \$33 non-refundable fee is applied to all returned checks, even if registration is canceled.
- 7. There is no prorating of fees. Program costs are as stated.
- 8. If registration is after the class start, payment is still expected in full.

#### Refunds and Transfers

- 1. Refunds must be requested prior to the registration deadline.
- 2. Refunds are not granted after the first class meeting.






The Parks & Community Services Department wants to continue providing Moreno Valley residents and families with services that make our City a great place to live, work and raise a family.
